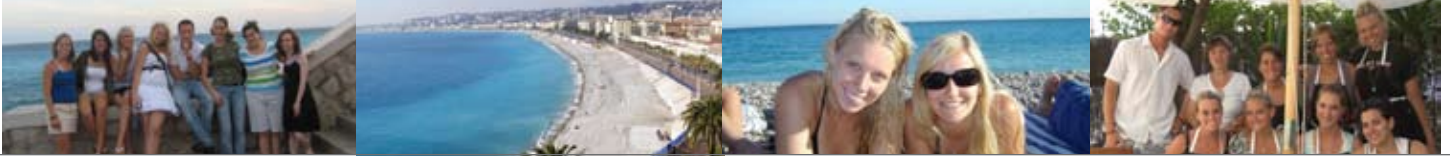

The University of Nice received its official status in 1965, but finds its roots in the 17th century as the renowned Collegium Jurisconsultorum Niciensium, created in 1639 by the Princes of Savoy. Today it is the second largest university in France with 27,000, of which 17% are international students. Students attend the International Summer University at the University. Transcripts are issued by the University of Nice.

Housing and Meals

Students will live in fully-equipped studios (all singles) in the city center, near Old Nice. Students will be able to prepare their own meals or enjoy one of the many eating establishments in town. Students can also opt for a meal plan which includes complete lunches on campus (Monday-Friday) for a supplemental fee.



Excursions

The program includes two excursions for the summer. Just imagine walking the streets of Corsica or snorkeling in the Mediterranean. Students have enjoyed strolling through Tende, an Italian-style medieval town, and hiking in the mountains. Other trips may include Monaco and Monte Carlo where you can tour the lavish palace, see the changing of the guards, or meander through the Jardin Exotique (Exotique Garden).
