The University Paul Cezanne – Aix-Marseille III is one of France’s oldest and most respected academic institutions. Abroadco students attend classes at the University’s Institut d’Etudes Francaises pour Etudiants Etrangers (IEFEE) and receive a transcript from the University, recognized by the French Ministry of National Education as a degree granting institution of higher education.

Housing and Meals

Students can choose to live in a shared apartment or in a French homestay. All housing is located in central Aix, an easy walk or short bus ride to the University.

In homestays, students receive breakfast and dinner five days a week. Students in apartments do not have a meal plan. Generally, students cook for themselves or eat at the many cafes and restaurants around Aix.



Excursions

The program includes two to four excursions, depending on the length of the program. With so many places to see, it’s hard to pick a favorite. Past students have enjoyed seeing Avignon, home of the papal court in the 14th century, and the famous bridge from “Sur le Pont d’Avignon”. Nimes is known for its Roman ruins and famous Greek temple. Les Baux de Provence is another favorite, one of France’s most picturesque cities. It’s renowned for the medieval ruins and Renaissance houses. So sit back and relax as you let your Onsite Director plan guide you in these once-in-a-lifetime opportunities to view ancient history while you enjoy the scenery!
