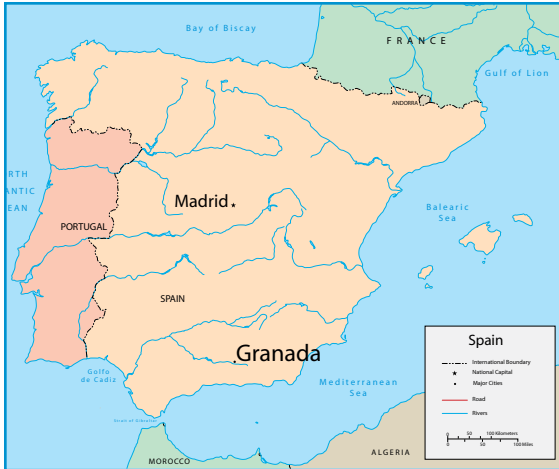


# Granada, Spain

Students attend the University of Granada's Modern Language Center. An integral part of the University, the Modern Language Center offers Spanish language courses to foreigners as well as foreign languages to Spanish students. Transcripts are issued by the University of Granada for all work completed at the Modern Language Center.

## Housing and Meals

Students can choose to live in a Spanish homestay or residence hall. Both living situations allow students to live with Spaniards, learning more about Spanish culture and improving their language skills.

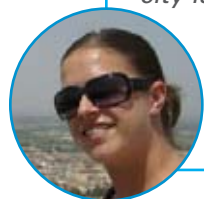
In both living situations students receive three meals per day/seven days a week. In addition, students will receive weekly laundry service.

## Excursions

The program includes two to four excursions depending on the length of the program. Students will visit traditional locations like Seville, Spain's most charming and romantic city, and Córdoba, filled with the old city's enchanting streets. With the beaches and mountains so close to Granada, students have enjoyed lounging on the beach or hiking and skiing in the mountains.
