Students will study at the University of Paris – Sorbonne (Paris IV) and/or The American University of Paris (AUP). Students at the Sorbonne will take French language courses at the Cours de Civilisation Française and receive a transcript from the University of Paris – Sorbonne. Students taking courses at AUP will receive a transcript from AUP which is accredited in the U.S. by the Commission on Higher Education of the Middle States Association of Colleges and Schools.

## Housing and Meals

Students can choose to live in apartments, residence hall, or homestays. Apartments are fully furnished and offer shared rooms with other program participants. The residence hall provides you with a single room and shared bathroom and kitchen facilities with others on your floor. Homestays offer a shared or single room with a French family.

In the homestay, students receive breakfast daily and dinner twice weekly. Meals are not included with the apartment or residence hall. Students often cook for themselves or sample one of the many restaurants and student cafeterias in Paris.



## Excursions

You're in the heart of France, yet there are so many other places to see! This program includes two to four excursions depending on the length of the session. You will visit both the destination as well as a few locations off the beaten path. Imagine yourself touring castles in Loire Valley, tasting champagne in the Champagne region, or seeing the famous markets of Provence. Other excursions may include a trip to a French farm where pigs are used in truffle hunting and see how foie gras is made, or a troglodyte village. Whatever the destination there will certainly be history, culture, and good food!
