Our ESL/FSL Co-op Program allows you to improve your English or French skills through study and work. Our intensive language courses give you the opportunity to upgrade your knowledge of English or French. Our internship program allows you to practice your newly acquired English or French skills in a truly North American work environment. We will prepare you with special Business English or French courses before you embark on your internship program. You can also take courses in both languages.

PRIVATE AND SEMI-PRIVATE COURSES

Courses given on an individual basis or to small groups are arranged to meet specific needs, in terms of course duration, scheduling and content. We recommend 30 hours to complete a level. However, the programs are available in units of 10 hours or more.

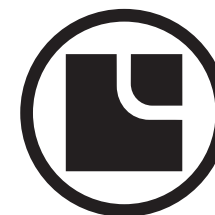

LANGUAGE PROGRAMS

INTENSIVE IMMERSION PROGRAM

Our intensive English or French courses give students the necessary language skills to go on to university. The program also prepares students to be fully functional in a work environment where they need to use English or French.

- 22.5 hours of classes per week.
- Up to 10 levels of English or French available each month.
- TOEFL and TOEIC preparation, advanced writing and conversation, college preparation.
- 12 sessions per year.
- Maximum of 15 students per group.
- A placement test takes place the day before classes start.
- A comprehensive medical insurance is obligatory for all non-Canadian students.
- Course fees include 2 educational activities.

- Languages: French, English, Japanese, Chinese, Russian, German, Spanish and others.

FOUNDATION PROGRAM

Study English or French intensively while taking one or more courses in a career program. Vocational courses are available in such fields as: Interior Design, Media Design and Print, Video Games, 2D & 3D Animation, Fashion Design, Fashion Marketing, Fashion Management, Business Management, Computer Science, Hotel Management, Restaurant Management, Tourism, Social Sciences and Special Education.

The Fall semester extends from September to the end of December, and the Winter semester, from January to the end of April.
