**Course length:** 5 weeks full-time



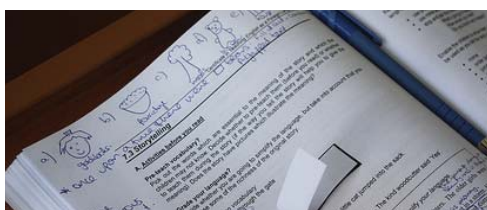
