### **Priority will be given to:**

- Students who demonstrate a keen interest in respective area of study and who want to gain further experience in the subject.
- Who have some familiarity / prior experience in the mentioned subjects and must be interested or currently pursuing related studies.
- Those who have had limited opportunity to travel abroad and/or no prior international travel experience

### **Scholarship Requirement**

- Recipients of ISAC scholarships will be required to pay their own airfare, and any personal expenses as outlined on the program description pages.
- Recipients of partial scholarships are responsible for the remaining balance of ISAC program fees.
- Recipients must keep a program and cultural immersion journal to be submitted to ISAC at the end of the program. They must take photographs while abroad, that may be used on the ISAC website, and in ISAC publications.

- Recipients may also be required to write an article about their experience for ISAC newsletters or other publications.
- ISAC will ask recipients to act as campus representatives for future participants, and may be asked to attend study abroad fairs in their local area.

**Deadlines for submission of completed applications (incomplete/ handwritten applications will not be considered)**

Deadline of November 15th, 2008. Selected candidates would be notified by email by 30<sup>th</sup> of November.
